MINUTES OF MEETING

Date/Time of Meeting: 16th June 2026 3 PM **Location of Meeting:** Conference Hall

The first meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee for the Academic Year 2026-27 was held on 16th June 2026 at 3:00 PM in the A/C Conference Hall under the Chairmanship of the Principal, Dr. G.V.N.S.R. Ratnakara Rao. The Convener welcomed all the members present and briefed the committee on the importance of maintaining a ragging-free campus environment in our institution.

Item No. 1: Review of Anti-Ragging Measures and Procedures:

The committee reviewed the anti-ragging measures implemented during the previous academic year. The members expressed satisfaction with the preventive measures adopted by the institution, including display of anti-ragging posters, awareness programmes, mentoring system, hostel monitoring and grievance redressal mechanisms. It was resolved to continue and strengthen these measures during the current academic year.

Item No. 2: Submission of Anti-Ragging Affidavits:

The committee discussed the status of submission of Anti-Ragging Affidavits by senior students. It was resolved that all Heads of Departments and Class Counselors shall ensure submission of duly signed Anti-Ragging Affidavits by all senior students in the 1st week of their respective academic instructions of the forth-coming semester. The concerned departments shall maintain records and submit compliance reports to the Convener.

Item No. 3: Awareness Programmes:

The committee resolved to organize Anti-Ragging Awareness Programmes for all students at the beginning of the academic year. It was further decided to invite officials from the Police Department and Mandal Administration to address students on the legal consequences of ragging and the importance of maintaining a safe and healthy academic environment.

Item No. 4: Constitution of Anti-Ragging Squads:

The committee has resolved to constitute Anti-Ragging Squads consisting of faculty members, physical directors, hostel wardens and student representatives for continuous vigilance and monitoring of vulnerable locations including classrooms, corridors, canteen, transportation facilities and hostels. The squads shall conduct regular inspections and submit reports periodically to the Anti-Ragging Committee.

Item No. 5: Additional Preventive Measures:

The committee discussed various preventive measures to further strengthen anti-ragging mechanisms on the campus. The following measures were suggested:

- Intensive monitoring during the initial weeks of the academic year.
- Regular counseling and mentoring sessions.
- Display of Anti-Ragging Helpline Numbers at prominent locations.
- Establishment of a confidential complaint reporting mechanism for students.

Item No. 6: Any Other Matter

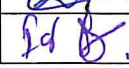

It has been observed that some prominent institutions are still following the previous exercise. You are therefore requested to adopt the revised procedure and not to receive any hard/ printed affidavit by students.

Anti-Ragging Undertaking must be filled by the students online on <http://www.antiragging.in> only. Universities/Colleges will not accept Anti Ragging Undertaking by students in Hard/Printed copy/Affidavits. **(Please note that the student is not required to print & sign it as it used to be in the earlier case).**

The committee discussed maintaining proper documentation.

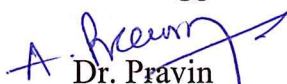
