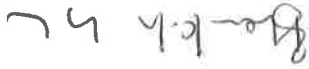

3) The detailed syllabi for I B.Tech. and I M.Tech. courses from 2018-19 Autonomous batches was ratified.

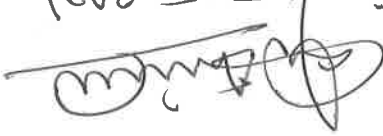
4) The academic calendars for both B.Tech. and M.Tech. first year programs for the academic year 2018-19 were reviewed and approved.

All Transfers from other institutions (Autonomous/Non-Autonomous) shall be as per the G.O.Ms.No.122, dated. 01/09/2005, G.O.Ms.No.66, dated.15/05/2008, G.O.Ms.No.03, dated.06/01/2011 by Higher Education (EC-2) Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh.

A) Internal candidates

Internal discontinued or detained candidates coming into I, II, III and IV years in A.Y: 2019-20, will be governed by the regulations under which the candidate takes readmission

B) Credit Equivalence for students shifted from other colleges

(i) Transfer candidates (from non-autonomous college affiliated to JNTUK) :

A student who is following JNTUK curriculum, transferred from other college to this college in second year first semester or subsequent semesters shall join with the autonomous batch in the appropriate semester. Such candidates shall be required to pass in all the courses in the program prescribed by the Board of Studies concerned for that batch of students from that semester onwards to be eligible for the award of degree. However, exemption will be given in the courses of the semester(s) of the batch which he had passed earlier and substitute subjects are offered in their place as decided by the Board of Studies. The student has to clear all his backlog subjects up to previous semester by appearing for the supplementary examinations conducted by JNTUK for the award of degree. The total number of credits to be secured for the award of the degree will be the sum of the credits upto previous semester under JNTUK regulations and the credits prescribed for the semester in which a candidate joined after transfer and subsequent semesters under the autonomous stream. The class will be awarded based on the academic performance of a student in the autonomous pattern.

(ii) Transfer candidates (from an autonomous college affiliated to JNTUK) :

A student who has secured the required credits up to previous semesters as per the regulations of other autonomous institutions shall also be permitted to be transferred to this college. A student who is transferred from the other autonomous colleges to this college in second year first semester or subsequent semesters shall join with the autonomous batch in the appropriate semester. Such candidates shall be required to pass in all the courses in the program prescribed by the Board of Studies concerned for that batch of students from that semester onwards to be eligible for the award of degree. However, exemption will be given in the courses of the semester(s) of the batch which he had passed earlier and substitute subjects are offered in their place as decided by the Board of Studies. The total number of credits to be secured for the award of the degree will be the sum of the credits up to previous semester as per the regulations of the college from which he is transferred and the credits prescribed for the semester in which a candidate joined after transfer and subsequent semesters under the autonomous stream. The class will be awarded based on the academic performance of a student in the autonomous pattern.

Disciplinary Action for / Improper Conduct in Examinations

Nature of Malpractices / Improper conduct	Punishment
<i>If the candidate:</i>	
1. Possesses or keeps accessible in examination hall, any paper, note book, programmable calculators, Cell phones, pager, palm computers or any other form of material concerned with or related to the subject of the examination (theory or practical) in which he is appearing but has not made use of (material shall include any marks on the body of the candidate which can be used as an aid in the subject of the examination)	Expulsion from the examination hall and cancellation of the performance in that subject only.
(a) Gives assistance or guidance or receives it from any other candidate orally or by any other body language methods or communicates through cell phones with any candidate or persons in or outside the exam hall in respect of any matter.	Expulsion from the examination hall and cancellation of the performance in that subject only of all the candidates involved. In case of an outsider, he will be handed over to the police and a case is registered against him.
(b) Has copied in the examination hall from any paper, book, programmable calculators, palm computers or any other form of material relevant to the subject of the examination (theory or practical) in which the candidate is appearing.	Expulsion from the examination hall and cancellation of the performance in that subject and all other subjects the candidate has already appeared including practical examinations and project work and shall not be permitted to appear for the remaining examinations of the subjects of that Semester/year. ACADEMIC REPORT for the Year 2018-19

The broad vision of the department is to provide valuable resources for industry and society through excellence in teaching, learning and research in the field of mechanical engineering. To accomplish the vision, the department has continuously organized various events related to curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the benefit of its stakeholders.

Following are the glimpses of some of the main events organized so far:

(A) CURRICULAR ASPECTS:

The Board of Studies of the department ratified the course structures of its UG and two PG Programs in the specializations of Thermal Engineering and Advanced Manufacturing Systems along with the detailed syllabus for first year of its respective programs in its **meeting held on 26th May 2018**. The following are the **highlights** of its Curriculum:

1. The Autonomous curriculum was designed by following some of the recommendations/ suggestions prescribed by AICTE in its latest revision of Curriculum for UG Programs (January 2018)
2. The total number of credits of the UG Program is 165

3. Major Changes in Design of Courses for UG Program:

- i) Every Semester one **Mandatory non-credit course** is introduced to make the learner acquaint with Courses relevant to Social responsibility, Culture, Human values and Professional Ethics etc.
- ii) To make the Program more Practical-oriented, One **additional Lab** (Engineering Mechanics Lab) is introduced in 3rd Semester.
- iii) To train the student on **Industry Oriented Technology**, a course on Industry-Oriented Technology Lab is introduced in 4th semester of the Program
- iv) A Minor-Credit **Certification Course** on Contemporary Industrial Technology is introduced in 5th Semester to make the student Industry-ready and grab the opportunities in relevant fields

v) To make the student to gain more practical knowledge, hands on experience and understand the latest Practices followed in Industry, **Industrial Visit and Internship** are made as mandatory courses.

vi) Electives:

- To address the local needs and serve the society a course on **Agriculture Mechanization** in 7th Semester of the Program, which includes design and fabrication of machinery for Coconut, Paddy and Aqua fields is introduced
- To update the knowledge on Automobile Engineering a new Course on **Electrical, Hybrid and Autonomous Vehicles** is introduced as an Elective Course
- **Safety Engineering** is offered as Open Elective in 6th Semester

(B) ACCREDITATIONS:

National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC) peer team appointed by University Grants Commission (UGC), visited the institution on 7th & 8th September 2018 and sanctioned accreditation with **3.9/4.0 GPA**.
The Department is going to face the National Board of Accreditation (NBA) peer team in due course.

(C) TEACHING-LEARNING:

The Department has been supporting student-centric learning through innovative pedagogy and ICT for effective delivery. Some of the pedagogic methods include Discussion, Learning by doing, Quiz etc. To promote self-learning, and achieve technical competency Students were motivated to take up Massively-open online courses (MOOCs) like NPTEL. A large number of students and a good number of faculty members have taken these courses and achieved certifications successfully

(D) SKILL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS:

To reduce the gap between industry & academics and make the student industry-ready several skill improvement programs like Workshops on AUTOCAD, CATIA, Advanced CATIA and REVIT MEP were organized for students in association with Andhra Pradesh Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC) and ENGINEAGAR Consultants Pvt. Ltd, Nepal.

(E) TRAINING-CUM-CERTIFICATION and PLACEMENT:

Around 50 students acquired AUTOCAD PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION (ACP) this year. A one-month long Training-cum-certification program on Non Destructive Testing (NDT) was organized for around 78 final year Mechanical Engineering students through FUTURE NDT and nearly 70 students were absorbed in various NDT Organizations through Campus placements.

(F) STUDENT PROGRESSION:

Towards achieving student progression, Expert talks from renowned National/International speakers in contemporary technical aspects, Industrial Visits, Student technical paper presentation contests were organized. This year Industrial visit to Dr. NTTPS, Ibrahimpatnam and APSRTC Zonal Workshop, Nellore were organized for III Yr Students. A National Seminar on "Sustainable Manufacturing" was organized for students on 22nd February 2019. Renowned International Academician Prof. P N Rao from University of IOWA, USA was the resource person for this event. A Student technical symposium "RESONANCE2K19" is scheduled on 16th March 2019.

(G) FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

To enable the faculty to acquaint with the latest developments two Faculty Development Programs were organized. An FDP on REVIT-Facility Development for ME faculty in June 2018 and an FDP on "Computational Fluid Dynamics and its applications-with an ANSYS FLUENT and MATLAB Orientation" was conducted in October/November 2018.

(H) INFRASTRUCTURE

A new lab on "Theory of Machines" was introduced in June 2018 to meet the new academic regulations of JNTUK (R16) and one more lab on "Mechatronics" will be established in May/June 2019.

To develop the research culture in students in the area of Robotics an "Applied Robot Control (ARC)" is going to be established in April 2019, as a part of Indo-European Skilling Centres in association with APSSDC. The Faculty training for "ARC" Lab has started from 7th March 2019.
